WeGo For Fun!

In March 2012 the **West Chicago Park District** is proposing the expansion of the following recreational and park facilities for the benefit of West Chicago residents:

1. In cooperation with the **City of West Chicago**, a new 70,000 sq. ft. Recreation Center located in the proposed Central Campus along Washington St. The proposed center would house multi-purpose gymnasium space, an indoor walking/jogging track, community meeting room, banquet area, dance studios, state-of-the-art fitness center, aerobics and wrestling rooms, indoor turf area and more.

2. Proposed development of Kress Creek Farms include synthetic multi-purpose athletic fields for a variety of sports such as soccer, football, lacrosse, softball and baseball. And restrooms, concessions, trails, and a certified remote flying field will also be added.
3. Completion of an adventure trail at Easton Park.
