VIII. Adjourn Open Meeting


Commissioner Voelz motioned to adjourn the meeting at 6:38 p.m. Commissioner Spencer seconded the motion which carried by voice vote.



Building Access/Opening

Renters will receive a personalized access code prior to their first rental date at Zone250. This code will be used to unlock and disarm the building. Your access code is: Please do not share this access code with participants or spectators.

To unlock the building, type access code into the keypad that is located to the left of the main entrance doors.

Example: Enter 1-2-3-4 on Keypad



Immediately upon entry to the facility, the alarm must be disarmed using the alarm keypad to your left as you enter the vestibule

To disarm the facility, type in your access code followed by the 1 (OFF) kev

Example: Enter 1-2-3-4-1 on Keypad



To unlock the main entrance doors, the ENTER switch must be set to YES. This switch is located in the top right corner of the main entrance door. The ENTER switch is the only switch that should be adjusted.

YES → Motion Activated Doors Open from Outside NO → Code Needed to Open Door

Building Closing

Before leaving, please check to ensure all participants and spectators have exited the building and lights are turned off. To lock the main entrance doors, the ENTER switch must be set to NO. This switch is located in the top right corner of the main entrance door. The ENTER switch is the only switch that needs to be adjusted



To arm the facility, type in your access code on the alarm keypad, followed by the 2 (AWAY) key. As you are exiting the building, you will hear the alarm keypad beeping - this is normal, and is giving a warning that the alarm will be active in 90 seconds.





Light switches for Courts 1 & 2 can be found on the wall to your right after entering the gym area.




Vending Machine Information/Refunds


To adjust basket height, type: 4-3-2-1-AAG-Basket 04 into the keypad, and hold the LOWER or RAISE key until baskets reach desired height


